



3 P'S OF PROMPT DESIGN

1

PERSONA

Who or what is your AI supposed to be?

Example: "Act as a high school English teacher at an international school."



2

PROBLEM

What is the goal of your prompt? What do you want to solve?

Example:
Help me to create a lesson on using words, phrases, and clauses as well as varied syntax to link the major sections of the text, create cohesion, and clarify the relationships between claim(s) and reasons, between reasons and evidence, and between claim(s) and counterclaims.



3

PARAMETERS

Personalization, constraints, examples, guidelines, data sources, etc.

Example:
I have three ELLs in my class. Two students already know how to do this.



TIPS

1. Minimize Hallucinations by prompting: If you are unsure about anything or cannot find a solution to my problem, ask me for help and clarification.
2. Get better results by using emotional language (at least for now): "I really need this to be good. My job depends on it."
